

Introduction to Implant Dentistry for the Dental Team

Subject area: Dental

Division: Care

Course summary:

This course is designed to develop the skills, knowledge and the role of the dental team currently involved or planning to become involved in implant dentistry.

What does the course involve?

This is a four day course totaling 24 hours of learning;

Day one and two

Focuses on an introduction to implant dentistry with learning taking place within the Schools state-of-the-art clinical skills room. Here, the team will experience simulated learning using implants and mandibles as well as developing knowledge and skills to aseptic technique systems.

Day three

Focuses on clinical treatment planning and pre and post and post operative cases studies. This session will develop all members of the dental team to ensure they have an active role towards patient care.

Day four

This surgical skills day will provide simulated 'hands on' experience of flap design and suturing techniques.
